Course Structure

This course builds on ANT 180: Introduction to Zooarchaeology. Current primary literature in zooarchaeology will be discussed in detail and used as models for the analysis of zooarchaeological data. The goals of the course are twofold: I) review the latest research and debates in zooarchaeological methods and theory and 2) learn how to analyze, present, and interpret zooarchaeological data, ideally using the student' own dataset.

Each session a student will guide discussion by placing the readings for the week in context, highlighting the main points of the articles and how they fit together, and providing thoughts for initiating discussion.

The course has a website on Canvas. Articles (primarily book chapters) that are unavailable from the University Library will be available there. Grades will be maintained there.
